Program

72 Holes of Stroke Play for Professionals and Amateurs (Ladies and Men)

- 29.09. Practice Round – Tee Times have to be booked through the Golf Course
- 30.09. 18 Holes Stroke Play
- 01.10. 18 Holes Stroke Play (Cut after 36 Holes 90 und ties)
- 02.10. 18 Holes Stroke Play (Cut after 54 Holes 60 and ties)
- 03.10. 18 Holes Stroke Play (Final Round)

Conditions of play

The championship will be played over 72 holes as a stroke play competition for Amateurs and Professionals and in accordance with the Rules of Golf of the R&A Rules Limited, and the Conditions of Play of the Austrian Golf Association 2019 (Hard Card) and such Local Rules as approved by the Championship Committee.

Eligibility

132 Players

90 Professionals (Male and Female) - **68 Spots reserved for PGA of Austria Members**

22 Professionals from recognized PGA's

If more than 68 PGA of Austria professionals register to enter the championship, Pros listed in the Austrian Order of Merit will take precedent.

If more than 22 non PGA of Austria Members register to enter the championship, Pros will be selected on a "first come first serve" basis.



42 Amateurs – 21 Male and 21 Female Players

Amateurs who are members of an affiliated Austrian or foreign golf club.

Hcp Limit: Male: - 4,4 Female: - 6,4

If more than 21 Male or Female Players register for the tournament, Players with the lowest handicap will be in the field first.

If the field is not full by closing date, the Championship Committee reserves the right to change the handicap limits.

If a category is not full by closing date, Players who are on the waiting list in a different category will be accepted to the field.

CUT:

After 36 Holes, the top 60 Players and Ties will advance to the final 36 holes.

Prize Money:

€ 20.000,- (Top 30 Professionals who are within the Cut)

Prizes will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed Players.

Tees

Male Amateurs and Male Professionals:	White
Senior Men:	Yellow
Female Amateurs and Female Professionals:	Blue
Senior Ladies:	Red

The distances from each tee box to the holes will vary 7% - 10% each hole.



Committee

The Committee will be nominated by the PGA of Austria.

Referees' decisions and the Committee's decisions are final.

Local rules and start times will be displayed on the club notice board.

The Committee reserves the right to amend the conditions of play before start of play.
